

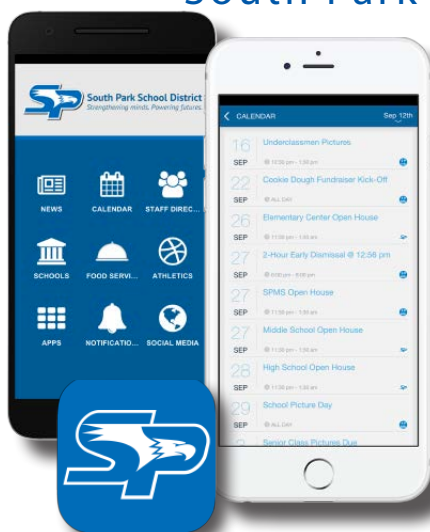

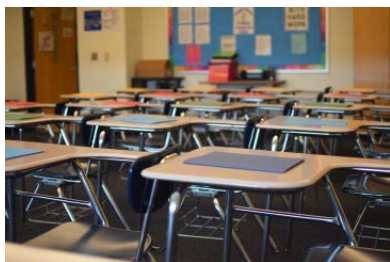
Brenda Lindsay

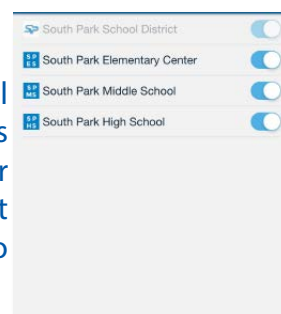
Make-up picture day at South Park High School is scheduled for September 22.
