

Student is Identified as a Close Contact* to a Positive COVID-19 Case

*Any individual within six (6) feet of the confirmed case for 15 consecutive minutes or more starting from two (2) days before they have any symptoms or, for asymptomatic people, 2 days before the positive specimen collection date

Is the student symptom-free and 18 and older and has received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters; is 5-17 years old and completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines, or had confirmed COVID-19 within the last 90 days (via a documented viral test)?

Student Does Not Need to Quarantine While Symptom-Free; Is to Wear Mask for Ten (10) Days from Exposure

Student Is to Quarantine According to CDC, PA Department of Health, and Allegheny County Health Department Guidelines. If Student Returns After Five (5) Days & Symptom-Free, Student Is to Wear Mask for Five (5) Additional Days



In School



Parents/Guardians Receive Electronic Notification of Close Contact Via Email

The email will ask parents to monitor child for symptoms for ten (10) days after exposure. While most emails will be sent within 24 hours of the district receiving notice of the positive case, emails may be delayed due to the volume of positive cases.



Student Who Is Close Contact Is Symptom Free



Parents May Choose to Send the Student to School or Quarantine the Student. If Student Begins to Show Symptoms, the Student Must Remain Home. All Close Contacts Are to Mask for Ten (10) Days from Exposure.



Student Who Is Close Contact Is Showing Symptoms



Student Must Stay Home From School; Parent/Guardian to Contact School Nurse.
