All students may bring reusable water bottles to use at water bottle refill stations. Single-use plastic bottles cannot be used at these stations.


HOMEROOMS

South Park Middle School students are to be in their homerooms by 8:10 a.m.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Middle school students may arrive no earlier than 7:50 a.m. Car-rider drop-off will be from 7:50-8 a.m. in the back of the building. Any student arriving after 8 a.m. must report to the office. All students must be in their homeroom by 8:10 a.m.

Car-rider pick-up will also be conducted in the back of the building. Parents/guardians may arrive any time from 2:50-3 p.m. Dismissal is at 2:57 p.m. The middle school will once again use a number-based pick-up system for pick-up. Numbers will be distributed to car-riders at the beginning of the year.



OFFICE EFORMS

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

As a reminder, unlike in previous school years, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has announced that breakfast and lunch meals will not be free for all students in the 2022-2023 school year. Breakfast is served every morning at South Park Middle School. The cost of breakfast is \$1.50. The reduced-price cost of breakfast is \$.30.

Lunch at South Park Middle School costs \$2.70. The reduced-price cost of lunch is \$.40.
